

## Getting Here

### Ronald Reagan National Airport

#### By Airport Shuttle

The hotel does not offer an on-site shuttle; however, Super Shuttle is available. Approximately \$13 per person one-way, roundtrip fares available. Contact Super Shuttle to schedule a pick-up: 1.800.bluevan or <http://www.supershuttle.com/>

#### By City Rail System

If you're taking the subway/Metro, take the Blue line (towards Largo Town Center) to Foggy Bottom. Take a left out of the escalator and continue towards Washington Circle. Follow the circle around to the left and turn left onto Pennsylvania Avenue. Take an immediate right on 24th Street and our hotel is two blocks up on the right.

#### By Taxi

Taxis from National Airport cost approximately \$20-25. It takes 15 minutes to get to the hotel.

### Dulles International Airport

#### By Airport Shuttle

The hotel does not offer an on-site shuttle; however, Super Shuttle is available from Dulles International Airport. Contact Super Shuttle to schedule a pick-up and get pricing: 1.800.bluevan or <http://www.supershuttle.com/>

#### By City Rail System

If you're taking the subway/Metro: take a Washington Flyer Shuttle from Airport to the Orange Line at West Falls Church. The rate is \$9.00 one way, \$16.00 round trip. Travel time between Washington Dulles International Airport and the Metro West Falls Church Station averages 20 to 30 minutes.

From West Falls Church, take the orange line metro towards Metro Center and New Carrollton. Exit at the Foggy Bottom Station. From there, take a left out of the escalator. Follow the hospital up to the George Washington Circle. Follow the circle around to the left and go left on Pennsylvania Ave, with an immediate right on 24th Street. The hotel is 2 block up on the right.

#### By Taxi

Taxis from Dulles International Airport cost approximately \$60-\$65. It takes between 45 minutes to an hour to get to the hotel.

## BWI Airport

### By Airport Shuttle

The hotel does not offer an on-site shuttle; however, Super Shuttle is available. Approximately \$47 per person one-way, roundtrip fares available. Contact Super Shuttle to schedule a pick-up 1.800.bluevan or <http://www.supershuttle.com/>

### By City Rail System

Metro offers BWI Express Metro bus service between BWI and the Greenbelt metro station. The service provides a direct connection between BWI and the Greenbelt Metro Station. The BWI Express/B30 service runs every 40 minutes, 7 days a week to the Greenbelt Metro Station, which is located on the Green Line of the Washington Metro System. Buses run 25 times each weekday and 21 times on Saturdays and Sunday, every 40 minutes. For more information call 202-637-7000 or go to [www.wmata.com](http://www.wmata.com). Total trip time is approximately 1hr 30 minutes to 2 hours depending on time of day.

Catch the BWI Express from BWI Marshall Airport. There are two WMATA Bus Stops. One is located on the lower level of the International Concourse and the other stop is located on the lower level of Concourse A/B. The B30 will pick you up outside at the bus shelter. Follow the signs that say "Public Transit."

Once at the Greenbelt metro station, board the Green Line train toward Branch Ave. Transfer to either the Orange(Vienna) or Blue Line(Franconia-Springfield) train at L'Enfant Plaza. Exit the train at the Foggy Bottom Station. From there, take a left out of the escalator. Follow the hospital up to the George Washington Circle. Follow the circle around to the left and go left on Pennsylvania Ave, with an immediate right on 24th Street. The hotel is 2 block up on the right.

### By Taxi

Taxis from Baltimore Washington Airport cost approximately \$70. It takes between 1 hour and 1 hour and 30 minutes to get to the hotel.

## Amtrak Train

Another way to Washington DC is to take the train. Take the Amtrak train (which leaves Baltimore every 20-30 minutes) to Union Station in DC. From Union Station, you could either take a 10 minute cab ride to the hotel that will cost approximately \$10.00, or you could take the Metro/Subway to the hotel which costs about \$1.35 per person. However, you have to transfer from the Red Line at Metro Center to the Blue/Orange Line to Foggy Bottom.

## Getting Around Town

### By City Rail System

The closest Metro station to our hotel is the Foggy Bottom Station. The station is about a 5 to 10 minute walk and is on the Blue and Orange lines. The hotel is also near many bus stops which can take you all around the city. [www.mata.org](http://www.mata.org)

### By Taxi

There is a taxi stand in front of the hotel, located on 24<sup>th</sup> street. It can cost approximately \$5 - \$10 per ride depending on your destination.
